The national investment for this season is approximately \$138 million, with additional flying and oncosts potentially reaching \$120 million in a moderate season, through a public-private partnership with Australian industry. NAFC welcomes \$51 million in funding from the Australian Government to support the national fleet.

### Developing national capability

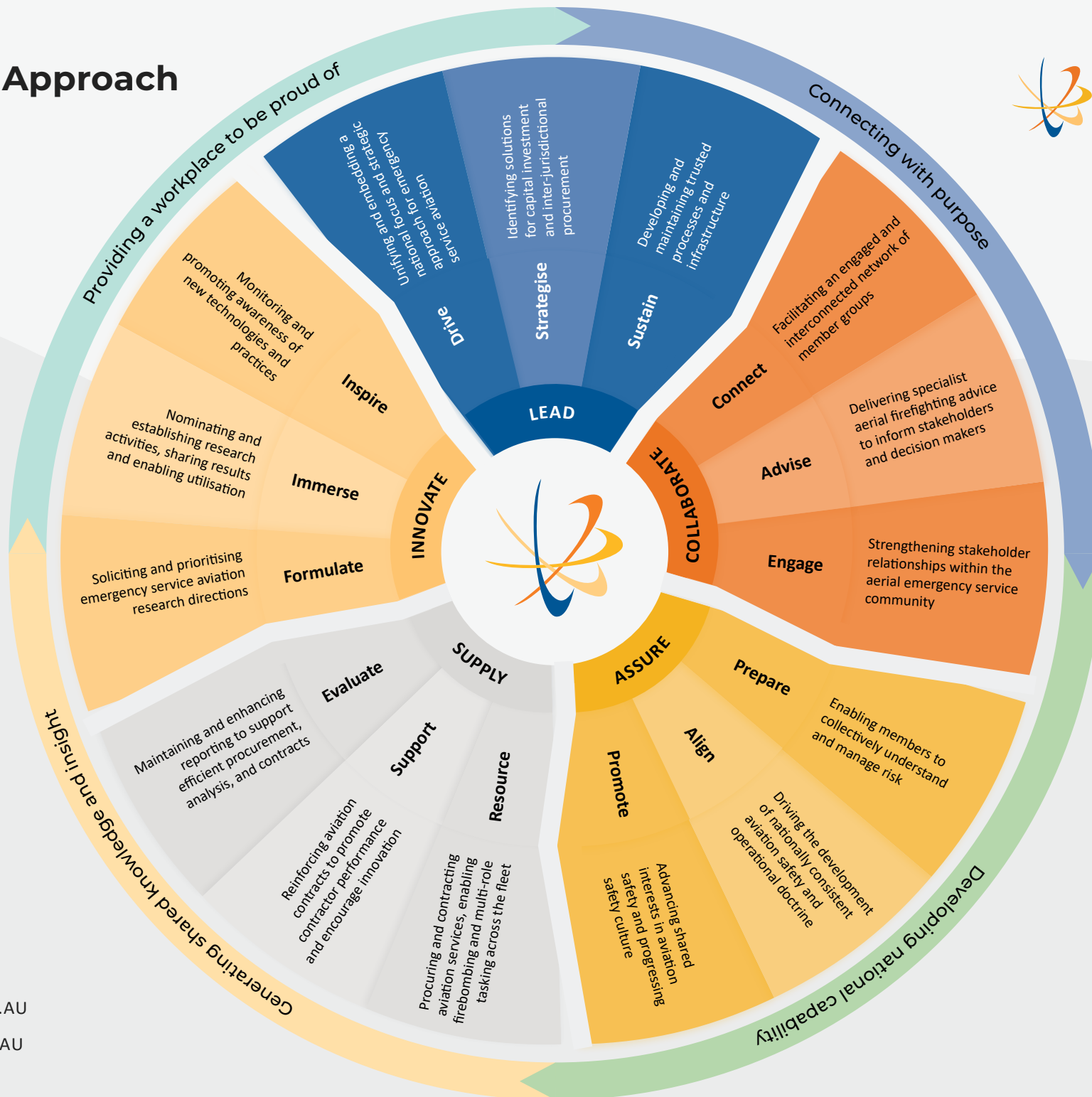
We extend the collective capability of our members through the development of shared doctrine, practice, systems and standards. We support the sector to advance workforce competency and develop emerging leaders.
